Meet D4K Lendon's Youth Dressage Festival Competitor Charlotte Bodkin

Charlotte Bodkin won the combined Second and Third Level Division at Lendon's Youth

Dressage Festival 2025.

Q: How many years have you competed at Lendon's Youth Dressage Festival? Charlotte: This was my first year competing at Lendon's Youth Dressage Festival. I am so excited that I decided to compete this year and this show helped me gain more confidence in the show ring!

Q:What was your reaction when you found out you were Division Champion? Charlotte: My reaction when I found out I was Division Champion was confused, yet shocked as it was my first year and I was the youngest rider in my division. But, super happy to know that all Frasier's + my hard work paid off!

Q: Can you tell us a little bit about your horse?

Charlotte: My lease horse's show name is Finish In The Blue, and his barn name is Frasier! He is a Bay Oldenburg yet despite his older age, always performs to his highest! We like to say he has a bit of an old-man personality as he does not get frightened by anything and probably knows more than we do! Overall, he is an amazing, chill, stunning horse who does his job very well!

Q: What's your horse's "superpower" in the show ring? Charlotte: Frasier's "superpower" in the show ring is his ability to remain calm and collected even when so many distractions are happening! Even when I have anxiety about showing, I know that he does not, and will perform just like the way we practiced at home!

Q: If your horse could talk, what's something they might say to you? Charlotte: If Frasier could talk, he might say "Where's my treat?" "Where's my fan?" or "Can I take a nap now?"

Charlotte: I would like to give a huge thanks to my trainers, Carol and Olivia.
